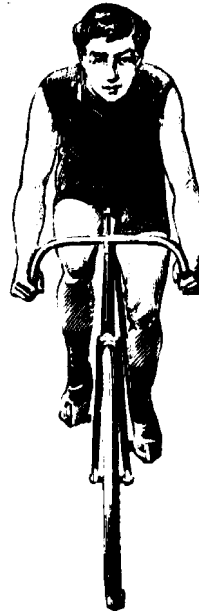

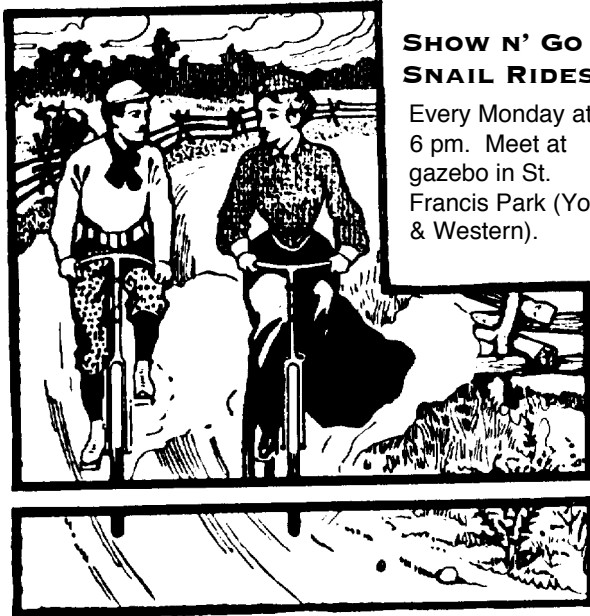
May 10--Family Fun Ride. Meet at Memorial Park Fieldhouse at 10 am

August 1--Family Fun Ride. Meet at Memorial Park Field house at 6 pm.

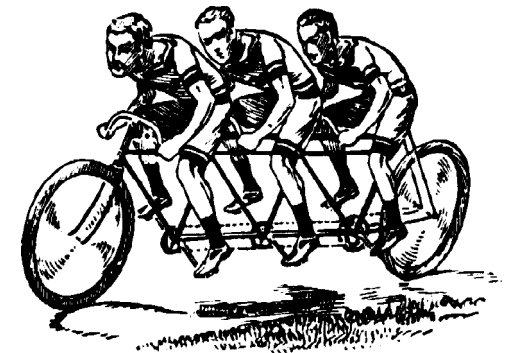
